PRIMARY JOB RESPONSIBILITIES


Assistant Director for Library Systems





CURRENT LIAISON ACTIVITIES

Informing faculty of new and existing research tools, methods, resources, and services. Collaborating with faculty to encourage the inclusion of the library as an essential component in teaching and learning. Creating and maintaining relevant library Research Guides to support the curriculum.
